SUBJECT: WSEU Dress Code Policy for Athletes and Coaches

Objective

The WSEU dress code policy is intended to show pride in taking part in any WSEU program or while participating in events and/or functions as representatives of the Club. It also develops discipline in the individuals that wear the uniform.

Definition

WSEU Athletes (“Athletes”) refers to any participant involved in any program run by WSEU including training Academies, camps, team practices, competitions, tournaments and games.

WSEU Coaches (“Coaches”) refers to the WSEU Technical Team, team coaches and their assistants who are approved by WSEU and appear on the official team roster.

Dress Code

All athletes and coaches are required to wear their WSEU gear/uniform to all games and practices.

All athletes are required to wear their WSEU practice and/or WSEU Academy training kits provided. One (1) grace period will be granted to a WSEU athlete who arrives to practice not dressed appropriately. They may be allowed to participate in a practice/training session *if and only if* they are wearing a plain shirt with no logos or graphics or a WSEU t-shirt or former WSEU uniform.

Present WSEU uniforms are *not* to be worn during practices.

Should an athlete require a secondary or replacement practice/training kit, this can be purchased by contacting the WSEU office.

Athletes who do not come dressed appropriately for practice/training will *not* be allowed to participate. This includes shin guards.



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EQUIPMENT	REQUIREMENT
Practice Kits (Jersey, shorts and socks)	Mandatory for all practices
Uniform Kits (Jersey, shorts and socks)	Mandatory for all games
Academy Kits (Jersey, shorts and socks)	Mandatory for all Academy sessions
Shin guards	Mandatory for all practices, games and Academy sessions.
Bags	Mandatory for all players
Track Suit	Mandatory for PR Mandatory for PD players U13+ Optional for PD players U12 and under

All athletes *must* be wearing shin guards during all games, practices and/or training sessions. This is *not* an option.

Dress Code for Functions

All coaches *must* wear Club approved clothing at all Club/team functions. This will include, but is not limited to, meetings, games, practices and banquets.

All athletes *must* wear Club uniforms/kits and/or tracksuits when representing the Club.

Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the WSEU Technical Team to educate all coaches regarding this policy.

Team Coaches – It is the responsibility of the team coaches, as representatives of the Club, to ensure that this policy is made known to all athletes and their families and to strictly enforce this policy.

Disciplinary Actions

Failure to adhere to this policy will result in the athlete and/or coach(s) being refused attendance at an event and may lead to further disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by the WSEU Technical Team and WSEU Executive.
